The women volunteers who are nominated for the Hall of Fame are the most valued assets of our community. This year the Hall of Fame will be held on Wednesday, October 30, 2019 at the City of San Marcos Rec Hall from 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Selection Criteria

Need – Nominee's volunteer service has met the needs of the community.

Action – Nominee has been actively involved in **more than one** area of service and over a sustained length of time.

Initiative – Nominee has demonstrated initiative in accomplishing service to the community.

Impact – Nominee has actively produced positive change and influenced others.

Time – Nominee has given substantial time beyond the call of duty.

Volunteerism – The service was provided in San Marcos on the volunteer's own time and not as part of her job.

Items to include in nomination packet:

1. Nomination form completely filled out.
2. Completed cover letter (maximum of two pages) explaining why this woman should receive recognition for her volunteerism
3. Letters of recommendation (three)
4. Summary of Volunteer Activities and Community Involvement (a current resumé can be submitted as well)
